The factory that produces Tidy Cats litter is located in Bloomfield, Missouri and employs approximately 225 members of International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers Local 1345. The 500,000 square foot factory was opened in 1976 and became a litter factory in 1995. Unique to the Bloomfield factory is the overhead bridge that allows full pallets of finished products to be conveyed to the nearby distribution center. The hard working members of IAM 1345 produce the traditional non-clumping litter sold in the bright yellow bags. They also produce the new Tidy Cats Lightweight litter, which is what I use, and Tidy Cats scooping clay litter.
